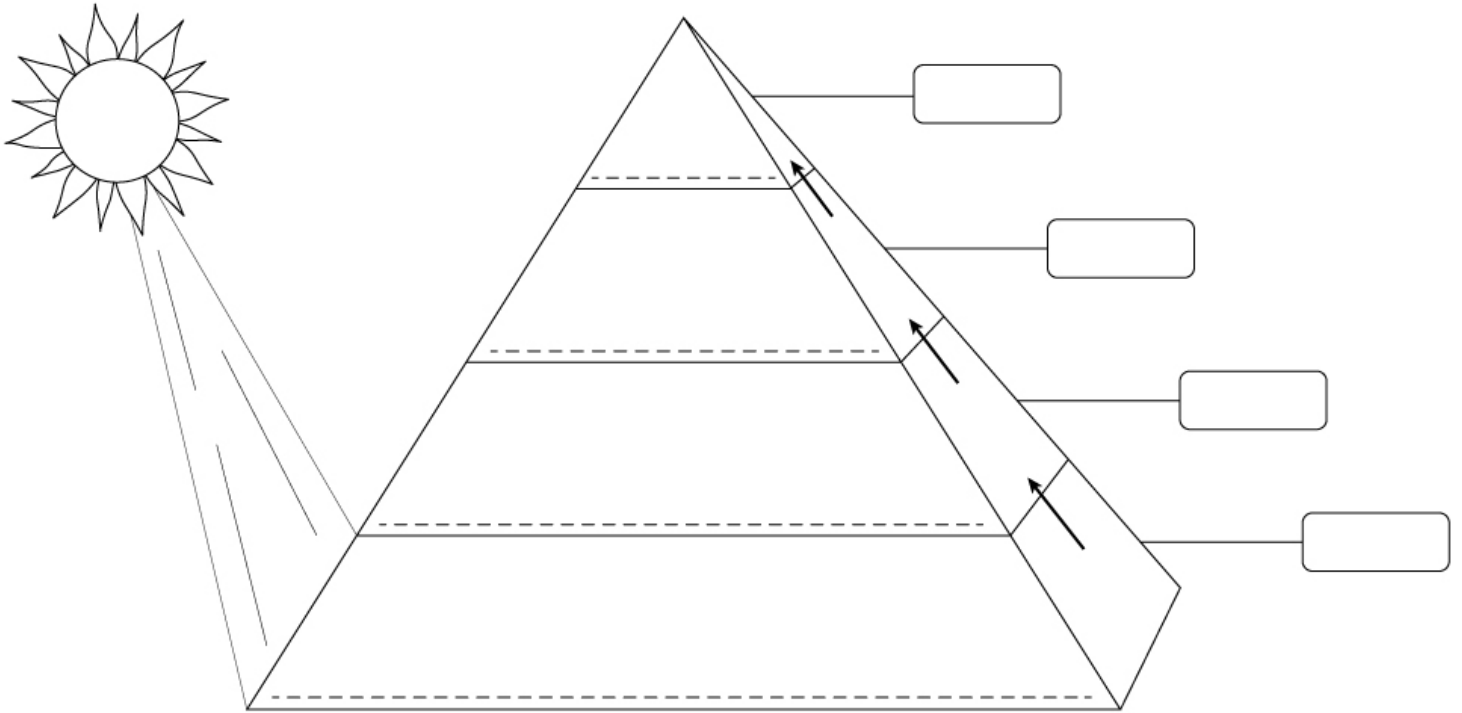


Energy Pyramid

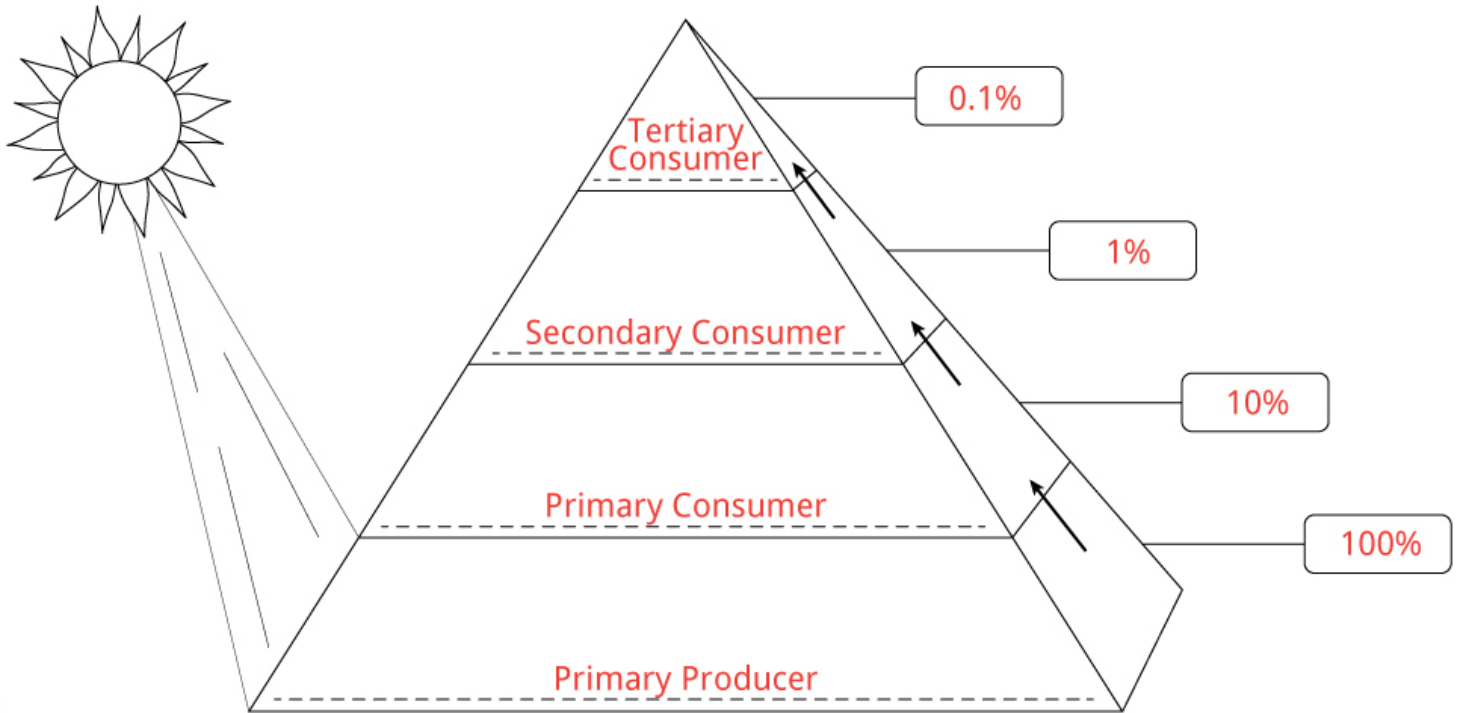
